PODS STARTERS, Dogs over 12 months, new to agility that have not competed before, other than nursery, foundation, or beginners at independent shows

Dogs may jump at the height they are training at

There will not be a see-saw or weaves in starters veteran or anysize

Veteran & Anysize combined. Dogs may jump at handler's choice of height.

PODS NOVICE Dogs over 18 months, who have competed before and are eligible to compete at K C Grades 1 2 & 3

PODS ADVANCED Dogs that have competed before and are eligible for K C Grades 4 or above

FROM MOST LOCATIONS: In Bryngwran. Pass The lowerth Arms, Then Turn Left into Narrow road.

Follow this road out of village under road bridge, pass Garage, Turn Right at Cross roads by White house. Follow the lane down a hill then bear right, continue over river bridge & Cattle grid. Pass Tyn Llidiart, Tai Lawr is next on Left.

PODS Agility Show Rules & Regulations,

1. Dogs do not have to be registered with the KC or any other organization.
2. Entries limited to 80 dogs (Not expecting that many!)
3. The entry fee (£10) is for all the classes the dog can compete in,- 2 agility, 2 jumping & up to 3 practice runs in ring 3. IF time permits 1 extra agility & 1extra jumping class.
4. Competition will start at 10 am.
5. **By signing the entry form handlers undertake not to knowingly bring to the show any dog suffering from an infectious or contagious disease.**
6. Marking will be as per Kennel Club competitions EXCEPT that in the starter class the first three refusals will not be marked.
7. Bitches in season may not be run.
8. Non competing dogs may be brought to the show.
9. **All dogs must be under close supervision at all times.**
10. Toys may be used in the starter classes NO Squeaks please.
11. Food must not be given in the ring; it may be carried but NOT DROPED! In starters class so no small bits please. Dropped food will upset other Handlers.
12. Judges may run their dogs in classes they are not judging.
13. Balls may be thrown in the exercise area BUT WITH CARE WE DON'T WANT DOGS ARGUING OVER BALLS. No toys or balls to be thrown near the rings.
14. There is a river at the bottom of the exercise area, dogs are welcome to swim but children must be supervised near the river, it is deeper than it looks!
15. **All dogs are entered at their owners risk, please ensure the dog is fit and look after the welfare of the dogs at all times.**
16. NO HARSH HANDLING WILL BE PERMITTED.
17. The show manager & secretary are the sole arbiter in respect of all matters relating to this show.
